Nancy Bushika opened the meeting at 6:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance, welcomed everyone, and read a statement with procedural rules for the meeting. **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

1. MOTION by Kurt Gamari to find that premature public discussion of a contractual matter and a personnel matter would place the town at a substantial disadvantage. SECONDED by John Dunn. All in favor. Motion APPROVED.

MOTION by Kurt Gamari to enter executive session for a contractual matter pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 313(a)(2) and a personnel matter pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 313(a)(3). SECONDED by John Dunn. All in favor. Motion APPROVED. The Selectboard entered executive session at 6:02 p.m. Sally Bohl and Dave Tatro were each invited to participate individually.

MOTION by Kurt Gamari to exit executive session. SECONDED by John Dunn. All in favor. Motion APPROVED. The board exited executive session at 6:30 p.m. The town will hire the attorney to follow up on the delinquent taxes. There was no action taken on the personnel matter.

#### BCRC REGIONAL PLAN

The BCRC has invited members of the Select Board, Planning Commission and Conservation Commission to attend a meeting, either in person or by zoom, to provide comments on the revisions proposed to the Energy Chapter for the 2026 revised plan. It will take place on January 15, 2026 at 2 p.m. and can be done from home.

#### 911 NUMBERING UPDATE

Bob Briggs was unable to attend but left word that he has reviewed about one-third of the town for 911 numbers and will continue working on it.

#### TOWN SIGN

Nancy Bushika acknowledged that the new town sign has been installed and the board agreed it looks very nice.

#### BUDGET WORK SESSION

#### REMINDERS

1. Townspeople should sign up with the state's free communications network, VT-Alert. You can sign up at [vtalert.gov](http://vtalert.gov) to receive notifications. You can choose how you would like to be alerted (phone call, text or email) and can choose what type of alerts you would like to receive, i.e. weather, road closures, public health, etc.
2. Anyone interested in serving as a lister should submit a letter of interest to the Select Board.
3. 911 House numbers must be affixed to your home or the entrance of your driveway to be compliant with state law.
4. The town office is open Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and on Thursdays from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m.; closed Mondays.

## PETITIONS FOR WARRANT ARTICLES & ELECTED POSITIONS

The deadline for filing petitions with the town clerk for warrant articles to be included in the town meeting warning is Thursday, January 15, 2026. These petitions must be signed by 5% of the registered voters or at least 38 signatures. V.S.A. 17:2642(a)

The required signatures on a petition to run for an elected office are 1% of the registered voters or at least 8 signatures. The deadline for filing these petitions with the Town Clerk is Monday, January 26, 2026 by 5:00 p.m. Nominating papers and the Consent of Candidate form may be picked up at the Town Office. V.S.A. 17:2681(a) (b).
